

Sustainability Statement (2023–2025)

As part of Arlington Fleet Services Ltd. commitment to the Greener Railway Strategy, we have taken decisive steps to measure, manage, and reduce our environmental impact across operations and supply chains. Between 2023 and 2025, our organisation achieved full Scope 1, 2, and 3 carbon accounting, integrating fuel, electricity, and water usage into DEFRA-aligned reporting systems.

Emissions Overview

- **Scope 1:** Red and White Diesel emissions totalled 307.62 tonnes CO₂e over three years, representing over 90% of our footprint.
- **Scope 2:** Electricity emissions declined 14% from 2023 to 2025, reflecting depot efficiency upgrades and behavioural change.
- **Scope 3:** Water supply and treatment emissions remained stable, with targeted conservation measures underway.

Strategic Actions

- **Fleet Optimisation:** We rationalised vehicle usage, flagged underutilised assets, and prioritised low-emission deployment.
- **Energy Efficiency:** Depot lighting, heating, and equipment schedules were reviewed to reduce kWh consumption.
- **Water Management:** Metering and leak detection programs were initiated to reduce waste and improve reporting accuracy.

Supply Chain Engagement

- We benchmarked supplier sustainability practices and initiated improvement roadmaps aligned with Network Rail's carbon reduction targets.
- All Tier 1 suppliers were engaged in transparent reporting of fuel, energy, and water usage, with quarterly reviews and feedback loops.
- We supported the transition to science-based targets and circular economy principles across our procurement activities.

Reporting & Governance

- Emissions data was visualised monthly and reviewed at the board level, supporting SECR compliance and strategic decision-making.
- Anomalies were flagged using root cause analysis tools, enabling targeted interventions and audit readiness.
- Sustainability metrics were embedded into operational dashboards and staff briefings, reinforcing cultural change.

We remain committed to continuous improvement, transparent reporting, and collaborative action—ensuring our operations contribute to a safer, greener, and more resilient railway network.
